Call to Order

Mr. Peterson presided over and served as secretary of the meeting. He noted that the meeting was held upon duly given notice and that all directors were present.

Approval of August 30, 2008 Minutes

The Board reviewed the minutes of its August 30, 2008 meeting. Following brief discussion, the Board unanimously approved these minutes.

Financial Report

Mr. Peterson reviewed for the Board the proposed budget for the Foundation, including estimated formation and ongoing expenses, as included in the proposed budget attached hereto as Exhibit A. Questions were asked and a discussion ensued.

Designator Dues

The Board then discussed the establishment of Designator dues in accordance with Section 2 of the Designators Agreement dated August 22, 2008. Subject to confirmation at the next Board meeting, the Board determined that the following dues structure would be reasonable to sustain the foundation:

- (a) for each Designator having at least 1,000 employees, the Designator dues would be (i) \$15,000 for costs associated with the formation of the Foundation and (ii) \$30,000 for each annual term ending September 30; and
- (b) for each Designator having fewer than 1,000 employees, the Designator dues would be prorated to be the product of (i) the number of such Designator's employees divided by 1,000 and (ii) the dollar amounts set forth in clause (a) above.

Election of Officers of the Foundation

Following discussion, the Board unanimously approved:

Resolved, that this Board extends its thanks to Mr. Peterson for his assistance as Secretary of the Foundation during its formation, and accepts his resignation from that position; and

Further, resolved, that each of the following individuals be, and hereby is, elected to the office of the Foundation listed beside his name, to serve in accordance with and having such authority as conveyed in the Article VII of the Foundation's Bylaws, until his successor is duly elected or until his earlier resignation or removal:
